Edict's Notice

Call for papers submission

1. With the objective of bringing to light the production of knowledge on the **female protagonism in the fight for the right to land in Iberian countries** the Instituto Nacional de Ciência e Tecnologia História Social das Propriedades e Direito de Acesso, *PROPRIETAS*, has decided to create the **Elizabeth Award**.
2. The **Elizabeth Award** aims to honor one of the most important leaderships of Brazil. It was in the name of her tragic and unforgettable fight trajectory that the INCT PROPRIETAS decided on the publication of this edict.
3. The competing works must be unpublished, in the humanities field, in any historical context of the Iberian universe, written in Portuguese or Spanish.
4. Necessary documents for the application:
 - a. A pdf copy of the text sent by email premioelizabeth@outlook.com;
 - b. A pdf of an one page presentation letter signed by the applicant in which they should demonstrate their work's contribution to the progress of knowledge in the field specified by the award. The letter must contain, necessarily, the following data: FULL NAME, E-MAIL, TELEPHONE WITH AREA CODE, FULL ADDRESS and INSTITUTIONAL AFFILIATION (where applicable).

5. The work's evaluation will be on the responsibility of the Evaluation Board (listed below) and will follow the following criterias: the relevance and originality of the work's approach on the relation between the female protagonism and the fights for the right to land, the updated dialogue with academic production on the theme, text's coherence, organization and presentation.
6. The works that were advised by any of the members of the board will not be vetoed, however the advisor will have to abstain from evaluating said work and therefore will not grade the applicant. The average grade, in this case, will exclude one of the board members.
7. The average grade will be calculated from the sum of the grades attributed by the board members, on a scale of 0.0 to 10.0, divided by the number of its components, except in the case established in the previous item.
8. The jury will publish only the names of the authors and the titles of the works approved in the first three places.
9. The first-place author will be awarded the physical publication and in e-book format of the work submitted, evaluated and approved by the jury, which may require revisions before the start of the publishing process.
10. The winner will also receive two plane tickets: to João Pessoa (PB) and to Rio de Janeiro (RJ) to present their work in Elisabeth's hometown.
11. There will be no appeal against the Jury's final decision.
12. Omissions in this Regulation will be resolved by the Organizing Committee and, when necessary, by the jury.
